

Friends of Hunter's Fleet - an exclusive offer for Friends

The yard is very enthusiastic about offering Friends the opportunity to hire half-deckers at late notice, where there is availability. The hire charge will be between one third and half the normal price. This is an exclusive arrangement for Friends and we are delighted to introduce this benefit. The details below apply to half-deckers only; we'll see about extending it to cabin yachts when we have some idea of how it is working out.

- 1. Last minute booking for evening sailing need to be made by phone to the Yard between 2pm and 4pm for pick-up that day and return by 9am next morning. Evening sailing will be charged at 1/3 of the listed day rate.
- 2. Late bookings for weekend hire need to be made to the Yard after 2pm Friday through to 4pm Saturday. Pickup can be any time after 9am on Saturday and return before 9am on the following Monday. These will be charged at 50% of the normal rate.
- 2. The weekend hire period runs to the following Monday morning. Longer periods may be available.
- 3. The boat hirer has to be an experienced sailor.
- 4. EITHER: The boat hirer has to have sailed with us since March 2023 and to have previously received and signed off a formal handover briefing. We need to be able to find the paperwork supporting this (to meet Broads Authority regulatory requirements) so you need to give us plenty of notice on your first booking.
- 5. OR: The hirer needs to have an initial formal handover with us during working hours. Thereafter, we will keep the signed briefing on file and you won't have to repeat this for future bookings.
- 6. The hirer <u>has</u> to complete a crew list before taking the boat out. This has to include the name and address of the hirer, names of crew, dates of birth if under 18, their own phone number and onshore emergency phone numbers. <u>There will be a blank crew list on-board in the information bag which you can fill out and put in the letter box. It will also include details of the accident excess. It must be signed by the hirer confirming that you agree to the conditions. This MUST be done before embarking (no excuses!).</u>
- 7. On booking you need to specify how many bouyancy aids you need. Every member of the crew must wear an aid. These will be put on board for you.
- 8. You can pick the boat up any time from the moment of booking (unless it is your first time as per 5. above). We don't need to be here for you to do this, so you can pick up on a Sunday, when we are closed.
- 9. You need to return the boat by the end of your hire period which, at the weekends, is 9am Monday morning. Please leave neat and tidy with the cover on.
- 10. On board, you will find an information bag. In it is our EMERGENCY telephone number. Please acquaint yourselves with this. You will also find the door code for the loos and showers.
